#### Uniform



#### Tips:

Make sure your card is filled with love.

Make it as creative as you can.

Ensure it has a legible message. (if a child's words are illegible, write in brackets underneath).

Keep your envelope unsealed to give the rest homes discretion to check cards if they choose.

Try to avoid religious quotes - your recipient may not be religious

Just be you!

All these cards will be delivered to local rest homes, through the **Sending Love** organisation.

Several families are on summer holiday at a remote camping site on an idyllic Coromandel beach, including various age groups of children. Some are happy to be there and others are not!


After the children are separated from the adults as a result of a landslide, they are left to their own devices.
