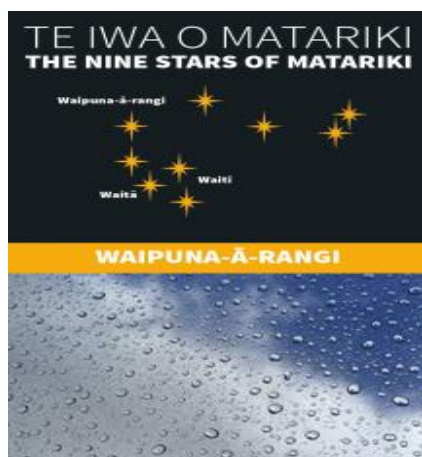
Pink Shirt Day

Year 7-8's

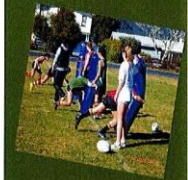
A series of festival days will begin on Monday 28th May at 4.15pm at Paeroa Domain. Just turn up and play – we will put you into teams or enter your own school team.
